Notice of Race 2018

1. Rules

- 1.1. Racing will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2. The Yachting New Zealand Inc Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply.

2. Alterations to Racing Rules

- 2.1. *rule 33* will include an alternate method of 'changing the course'
- 2.2. *rule 35* will be extended to say: "any boats that have not finished within 15 minutes of the first boat, may be scored as DNF"

3. Eligibility and Entry

- 3.1. The regatta is open to all Laser 4.7, Radial and Standard and all other centreboard classes.
- 3.2. Advance entries will be accepted by completing the attached entry form accompanied by a fee of \$10 for entries and mailing it to Panmure Lagoon Sailing Club Inc, C/- The Treasurer, 14 Bryant Place, Glendowie, Auckland 1071
- 3.3. Entries can be lodged in person at Registration on 21st April at 8:30am. Late entries are accepted at the Race Committee's discretion.
- 3.4. Any change of crew to that nominated, to be requested of the Race Committee prior to the change.
- 3.5. There will be two fleets racing: A Fleet and Intermediate Fleet
 - 3.5.1. **A Fleet:** Proficient sailors, who have participated in an open fleet laser regatta.
 - 3.5.2. **Intermediate Fleet** - Sailors who have not sailed in an open fleet regatta. It is open to less experienced Laser sailors. The emphasis is on fun and the objective of this regatta is to offer the less experienced sailors the opportunity to sail, participate and to practice and hone racing skills without feeling intimidated by experienced sailors.

4. Racing Schedule

Saturday 21st April:

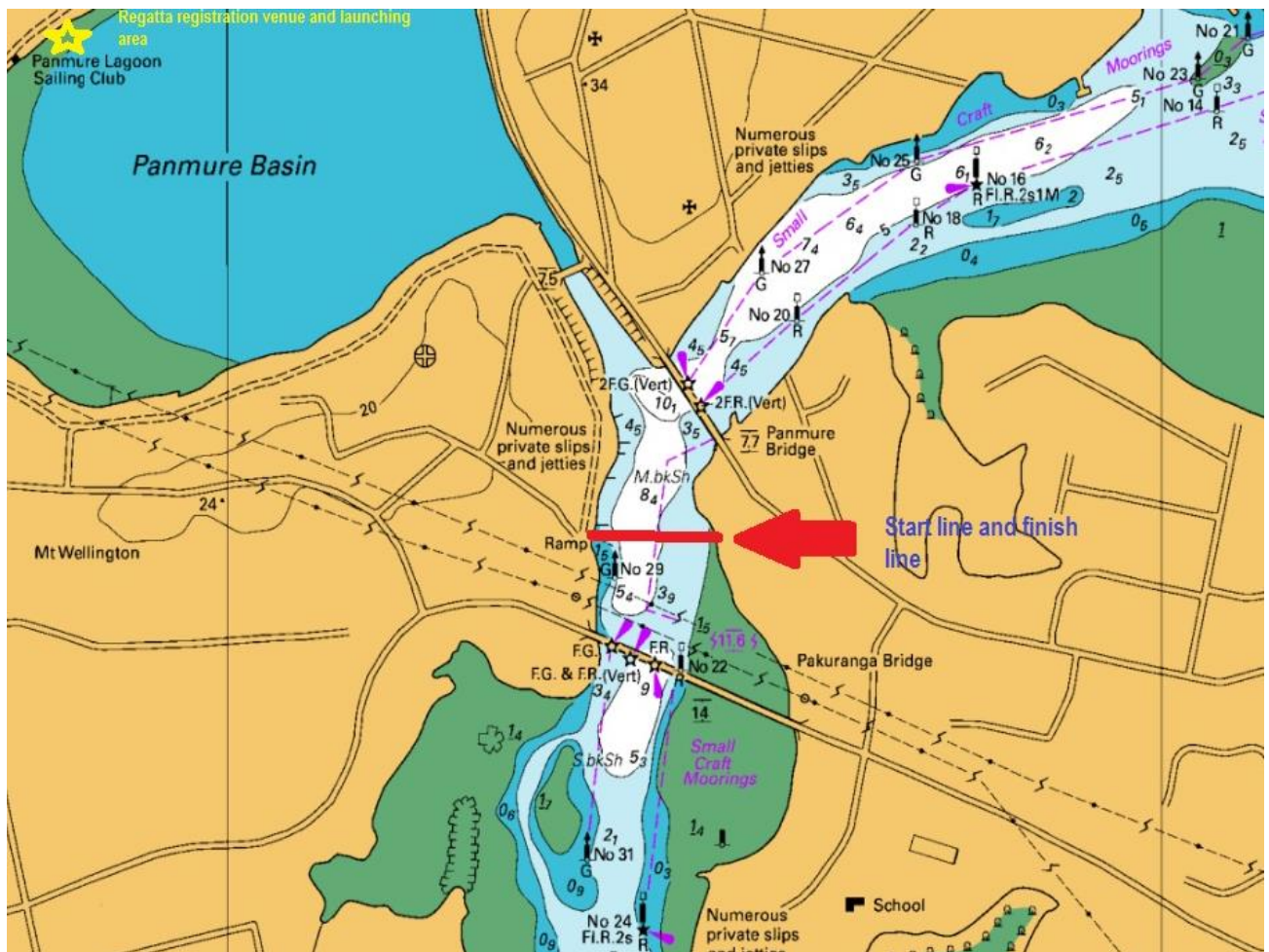
- 08:30 am - Registration
- 09:20 am - Briefing
- 09:35 am - Boats are launched
- 10:00 am - Times of first warning signal.

5. Sailing instructions

The Sailing Instructions will be available upon registration.

6. Racing Area

This is a point to point race on the Tamaki Estuary. The race will begin between the green jetty off Waipuna Road East and a patrol boat, then down the Tamaki River up to Curlew Bay to the red navigation buoys leaving them to starboard, down to a placed orange buoy on the East side of Curlew Bay off Sea Side Park and back to the Red Navigation buoy near the motorway leaving it to Starboard then returning to the start finish line between the green jetty off Waipuna Road East and a patrol boat. Please **take caution** at the start as the tide currents are quite strong and if you are over during the start procedure, you might not be able to come back.




Dangers to Note:

- This is a narrow navigation area with restricted movement for large vessels so give them room to safely navigate.
- Normal navigation rules will apply at all times.
- Keep clear of moored boats.
- The rowing club uses this area as well so keep clear of all rowing skiffs, dragon boats, wakas & their coach boats
- Be aware of unusual and at times severe wind currents around man-made structures e.g. bridges, buildings.
- Keep well clear of pylon structures supporting road above.

7. Start Sequence

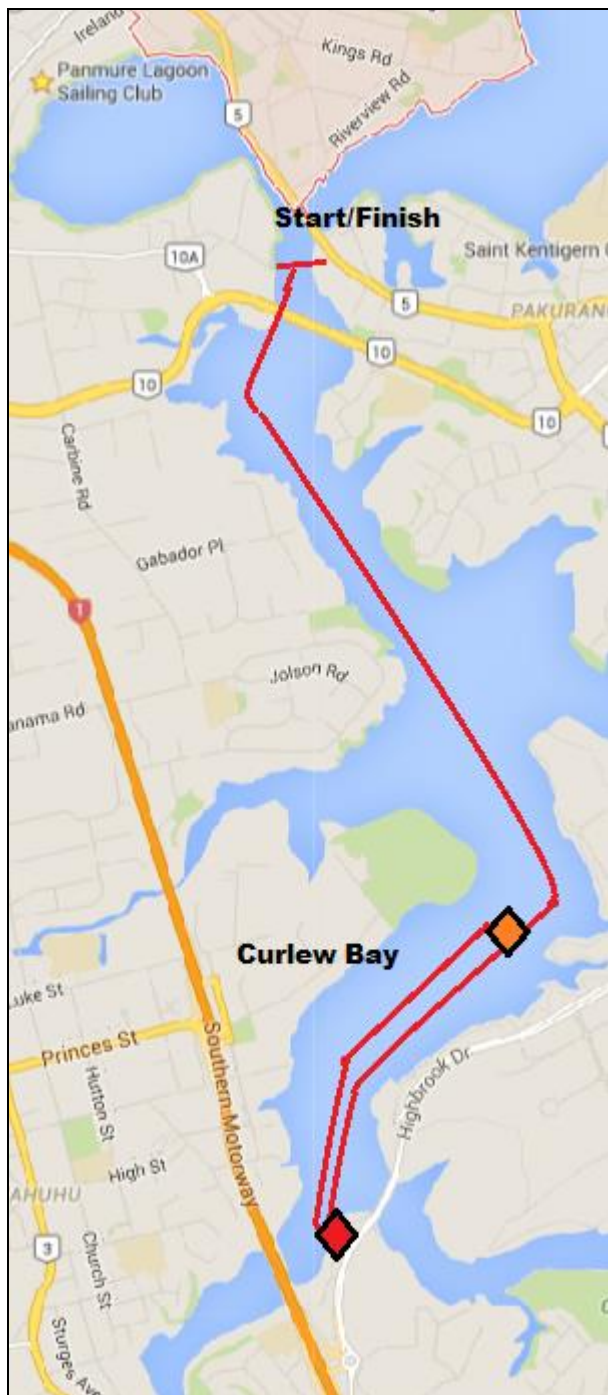
Races will be started with a 3-minute (3, 2, 1, 30 Second go) sequence.

Races shall be started by using the following signals. Times shall be taken from the visual signals; the absence of a sound signal shall be disregarded.

Signal	Flag and sound	Minutes before starting signal
Warning	Class flag; 1 sound	3-min
Preparatory	P 1 sound	2-min
One-minute	Preparatory flag removed; 1 long sound	1-min
	30 Seconds Sponsor flag goes up	30 seconds
Starting	Class flag and 30 Seconds flag removed; 1 sound	0

8. Courses to be sailed

The courses to be sailed will be a point to point race. Below is the proposed course & will be confirmed on the day of the Regatta at briefing.



A Fleet

- 1st Leg: Green jetty off Waipuna Road East to red channel markers near the motorway leaving it to Starboard
- 2nd Leg: Red channel mark to laid orange buoy East end of Curlew Bay leaving it to starboard
- 3rd Leg: Orange mark to red channel mark at motorway leaving it to starboard
- 4th Leg: Red channel mark to finish at the start line

B Fleet

- 1st Leg: Green jetty off Waipuna Road East to laid orange buoy East end of Curlew Bay leaving it to starboard
- 2nd Leg: Orange buoy East end of Curlew Bay mark to finish at the start line

9. Scoring

9.1. A competitor will be scored with the rating of that rig that it enters for this regatta.

9.2. Class Ratings

All Classes will be governed by the Portsmouth yardstick handicap rating system.

10. Disclaimer of Liability

10.1. Competitors participate entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race.

10.2. The Organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

11. Prizes
