RULES FOR THE USE OF CLUB PROPERTY

GENERAL RULES

1. These rules will replace all previous versions of rules.
2. These rules cover PLSC property, which belongs to PLSC and may not be considered to be the property of any individual member or group of members of PLSC.
3. The use of PLSC property by members and non-members of PLSC is for private pleasure purposes and shall always be at the discretion of the elected committee of PLSC and its officers.
4. Activity fees for the use of PLSC property shall be paid by the user in full prior to use.
5. The activity fee is charged daily for club events and if club property is used for external events then the fee applies for a 24-hour period.
6. Except for special circumstances where PLSC Committee has given approval, PLSC boats shall be sailed only on scheduled sailing days.
7. Users shall sign on and agree to these rules prior to using PLSC property.

MAINTENANCE

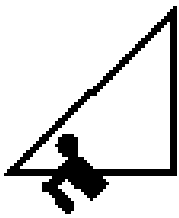
8. Members of PLSC shall take all reasonable care of club property assigned to them. The Club Committee shall reserve the right to charge the user for the cost of any repairs required as a result of damage to any PLSC equipment sustained where such damage is not covered by insurance.
9. Boats and other equipment shall be rinsed in fresh water after use and shall be returned in good condition to appropriate lockers.
 - a. Do not take or swap equipment from new boats or those on beach trolleys.
 - b. Do not take any Club equipment home.
10. Where indicated, rivets and other fastenings shall be sprayed with water-repellant material (e.g. "CRC") prior to return of equipment to storage.
11. Sails shall be slab-folded without battens.
12. Any damage to PLSC property that occurs or becomes apparent during use shall be reported by the user to the Club Captain or, in the absence of the Club Captain, to another member of the Club Committee.

SAFETY

13. A Lifejacket (Personal Flotation Device) shall be worn by the user at all times when PLSC property is used on the water. Where the user does not have their own lifejacket, PLSC will supply a suitable lifejacket at no additional fee.
14. Whenever PLSC boats are sailed on Panmure Lagoon a patrol boat propelled by outboard motor shall be deployed.

PRIORITY AND SUITABILITY OF USERS

15. Financial members of PLSC shall always have priority over non-members for use of club property.

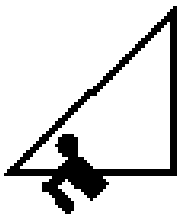

16. The Club Captain or, in the absence of the Club Captain, a qualified sailor on the Club Committee shall determine the suitability of any person to use club property.
17. All users must:
 - a) be at least qualified to level 1 YNZ dinghy sailing.
 - b) be able to rig and unrig a boat.
 - c) advise of health or other conditions that could be hazardous to sailing
18. If necessary the Club Committee shall decide any contentious issues regarding suitability of users or priority.
19. In the event of an excess of users over available equipment then the early arriver shall have priority over the late arriver — "First come first served." However Rules 15, 16, 17 have priority over Rule 19.

SPECIAL RULES FOR USE OF CLUB PROPERTY AT EXTERNAL REGATTAS

20. Rules 1 to 19 shall also apply to the use of club property at external regattas (organised events at venues other than Panmure Lagoon).
21. In addition the user shall apply to PLSC Committee prior to each event.
22. PLSC Committee shall decide each application.
23. If the Club Captain is not at the Committee Meeting that agrees to release equipment to a member for an external regatta then he shall be informed of the committee's decision as soon as practicable.
24. Users shall sign a document declaring that they are using the equipment at their own risk and that they are capable of handling a boat in winds over 25 knots.
25. Daily activity fees shall apply to each day that the equipment is away from the PLSC lockers.
26. Payment shall be made in full to the Treasurer prior to use.
27. Use of boats and other PLSC equipment by members for external regattas shall be on the basis that the equipment is taken from the club lockers straight to the venue and returned directly to the club lockers at the conclusion of the event.
28. Members shall not store PLSC property at home without prior approval of PLSC Committee.
29. PLSC boats shall be sailed only during daylight hours. Except for special regattas that include provision for night sailing (eg OKI 24-hour regatta)
30. A logbook shall be kept with details of all PLSC property used at external events. Details shall include dates, name of user, description of equipment, condition of equipment before and after use.
31. The Club Captain (or nominated deputy) shall inspect the equipment before and after each excursion.
32. Road Trailer — The road trailer that belongs to PLSC may be used for an additional daily fee (see current activity fees charged at time of use).
33. Any fines incurred during the use of the PLSC road trailer shall be the responsibility of the user and not the responsibility of PLSC.

Laser Dinghy (new):	\$20.00 per day
Laser Dinghy (intermediate age):	\$15.00 per day

Optimist:	\$ 5.00 per day
Open Bic:	\$10.00 per day
Road Trailer:	\$ 5.00 per day
Kayak:	\$ 5.00 per day

However, PLSC cannot be responsible for hazards that are not within its control and disclaims responsibility for any injury arising from such hazards.

PLSC and its members disclaim responsibility for storage of boats and other equipment in the lockers. All equipment stored in PLSC boat lockers is at your own risk.

PLSC holds no responsibility to the public or liability in the use of buildings or outside grounds that may cause damage to your person or to your property.

Boats, lifejackets and other equipment are on loan from PLSC. You sail the boats and use the equipment at your own risk. PLSC will in no way render any physical or financial support in the event of misuse of equipment during the period of a loan, i.e. from the time it is loaned to the time it is returned to the lockers.
