## NOTICE OF RACE & REGISTRATION FORM

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### Notice of Race (NoR)

The Organising Authority is

#### **PANMURE LAGOON SAILING CLUB INC**

100A Ireland Road, Mt Wellington, Auckland, New Zealand

#### **1. Rules**

- 1.1. The event is governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*.
- 1.2. The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply.
- 1.3. There will be an alternate method of *changing the next leg of the course*. This changes *RRS Rule 33*
- 1.4. *Rule 35* will be extended to say: *any boats that have not finished within 15 minutes of the first boat, may be scored as DNF.*
- 1.5. *Appendix T, Arbitration* will apply.

#### **2. Sailing instructions**

- 2.1. The Sailing Instructions will consist of the instructions in *RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions* and supplementary sailing instructions that will be available upon registration.

#### **3. Communication**

- 3.1. The online official notice board is on TEAM APP 📱 *Panmure Lagoon Sailing Club*.

#### **4. Eligibility and Entry**

- 4.1. The regatta is open to all boats of the *Laser 4.7, Laser Radial* and *Laser Standard* class
- 4.2. Eligible boats may enter by completing the [on-line entry form](#) and by bank direct crediting the \$15 entry fee, by Thursday 29<sup>th</sup> April.
- 4.3. Late entries can be lodged in person at Registration on 2<sup>nd</sup> May at 8:30am. Late entries are accepted at the Race Committee's discretion.
- 4.4. The regatta is limited to **50 entries**.
- 4.5. To be eligible to compete in this event each competitor shall be a financial member of a club recognised by the competitor's national authority.

#### **5. Racing Schedule**

Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> May:

- 08:30 am - Registration
- 09:45 am - Briefing
- 10:00 am – Scheduled time for first warning signal. 5 races back to back.

#### **6. Venue**

- 6.1. The regatta venue is Panmure Lagoon Sailing Club, 100a Ireland Rd, Mt Wellington.
- 6.2. The racing area is the waters of the Panmure Basin [36.54.3S 174.51E].

#### **7. Courses to be sailed**

- 7.1. The courses to be sailed will be triangular windward/leeward.

#### **8. Penalty System**

- 8.1. *RRS 44.1* is changed so that the Two-Turns penalty is replaced by the One-Turn penalty.

#### **9. Scoring**

- 9.1. Three races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

#### **10. Risk Statement**

- 10.1. *RRS 3* states: *The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.* By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting



in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.

#### **11. Insurance**

11.1. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid marine third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$1,000,000 per incident or the equivalent.

#### **12. Prizes**

12.1. The following prizes will be awarded: prizes for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> in Standard, 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> in Radial, 1<sup>st</sup> in 4.7 as well as 1<sup>st</sup> Woman and 1<sup>st</sup> Junior. Spot prizes will be drawn and awarded to entrants who are present at the prize giving ceremony, which will be held as soon as possible after racing.
